<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Universal Protocol #601</li> <li>• Monitor for allergic reaction – Protocol #611</li> <li>• Insect Bite                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Remove stinger</li> <li>○ Apply ice</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Animal Bite                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Hemorrhage control per Hemorrhage/Hemostatic Dressing Procedure # 706 as indicated</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Snake Bite                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Do not delay transport</li> <li>○ Remove constricting items near the site</li> <li>○ Mark area of swelling and record time</li> <li>○ Irrigate wound – DO NOT apply ice</li> <li>○ DO NOT incise or attempt suction of venom</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Marine envenomation                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Jellyfish                                     <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Do not apply heat</li> <li>▪ Rinse with Normal Saline (vinegar or baking soda if available)</li> </ul> </li> <li>○ All others                                     <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Remove barb if necessary</li> <li>▪ Apply warm compresses</li> </ul> </li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<p>Same as Adult</p>
