**Trial Radio Reporting Study with Marian Medical Center**

With the new EMS Policy #121 EMS Base Station Report, San Luis Obispo County (SLO) EMSA and Santa Barbara County EMSA have agreed to conduct a trial study of direct medic radio communication with Marian Medical Center (MMC) for select call types.

**Beginning May 1, 2017 at 0800 hours** SLO paramedics may communicate directly with (MMC) for patients being transported to MMC in the following circumstances:

- EMS calls that DO NOT require medical direction, destination, or requests for medications, including:
  - Notifications
  - STEMI Alerts
  - Trauma Alerts
  - Stroke Alerts
  - ROSC
- Any call requiring destination, medication, or a physician consult shall follow SLO Policy and Procedures for medical control and destination, including:
  - Trauma destination for Step 3 and Step 4
  - Medications requests
  - Termination orders
  - Physician consults
- Contact with MMC shall be made via cell phone to the dedicated ED recorded lines
  - Primary contact – Hotline **805-925-7108**
  - Back up contact – Radio on Med 2
- The reporting ALS agency shall work with MMC to provide patient information requested and understand this may be in excess of the short notification format used in SLO County
- MMC shall record all incoming calls
- MMC is of the understanding that no medical direction or medication orders shall be given to SLO EMS agencies

**It is the responsibility of the EMS Providers to ensure that all EMS personnel receive this information**
