<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Universal Protocol #601 • Pulse Oximetry <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ O₂ administration per Airway Management Protocol #602 • Monitor for allergic reaction – Protocol #611 • Insect Bite <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Remove stinger ○ Apply ice • Animal Bite <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Hemorrhage control per Hemorrhage/Hemostatic Dressing Procedure # 706 as indicated • Snake Bite <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Do not delay transport ○ Remove constricting items near the site ○ Mark area of swelling and record time ○ Irrigate wound – DO NOT apply ice ○ DO NOT incise or attempt suction of venom • Marine envenomation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Jellyfish <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Do not apply heat ▪ Rinse with Normal Saline (vinegar or baking soda if available) ○ All others <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Remove barb if necessary ▪ Apply warm compresses
